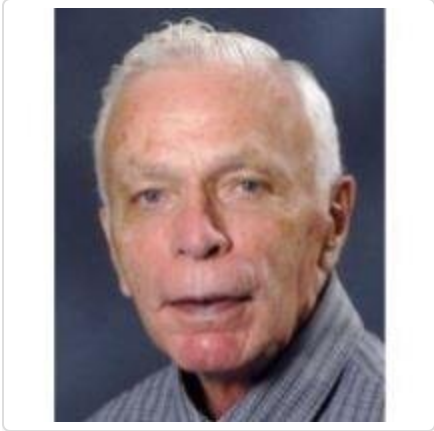




Art Mosher

WASHINGTON – Arthur F. Mosher, 77, of Washington, IL, died at 5:32pm Tuesday, April 27, 2010 at OSF St. Francis Medical Center in Peoria, IL.

Born on December 6, 1932 in East Peoria, IL, to Charles W. and Theresa E. Klug Mosher, he married Martha Louise McCurdy on August 30, 1958 in Wyoming, IL. She survives.

Also surviving are one daughter, Julie (Steve) Southey of Champaign, IL, one son Michael (Samia) Mosher of Plainfield, IL, one brother, Charles (Paula) Mosher of Effingham, IL, and four grandchildren, Megan, Jacob, Jared, and Briana.

He was preceded in death by two sisters.

Art was a US Army veteran, serving in the Korean Conflict for two years. He was a Finance and Traffic Analyst at Caterpillar Inc. in Peoria for 30 years, retiring in 1986. He also worked for Advanced Technology Services in Peoria for seven years after his retirement.

He was a Charter member and officer of the Northern Tazewell Jaycees for three years. Art also was a member and served as a deacon and elder at Sunnyland Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Washington.

Services will be at 10 am Saturday, May 1, 2010 at Deiters Funeral Home and Crematory in Washington. Rev. Evan Williams will officiate. Visitation will be from 5-7 pm Friday, April 30, 2010 at the funeral home. Burial will be in Glendale Cemetery in Washington.
