Brice E. Bain, 64, of East Peoria, passed away at 6:50am, July 12, 2017, at Snyder Village in Metamora, IL.

He was born September 22, 1952, in Peoria, IL to E. Fenton and Darlene O. (Cottle) Bain. He married Kimberly A. (Petri) Bain on May 25, 1974, in Peoria, IL.

was involved. When Nick wanted to play soccer Brice went to a bookstore and bought every soccer book he could find to learn the rules of the game, in order to coach Nick's team. He was a "diehard" Cub Fan and was elated when they finally won the World Series. His main passion was his family and his Church. He was a member of First Christian Church of Peoria all of his life. He loved his church and held various positions. He was honored to receive the title of Elder Emeritus.

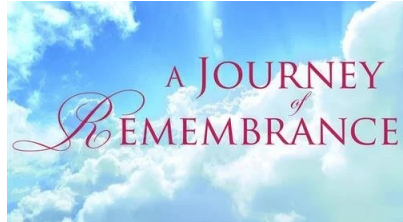

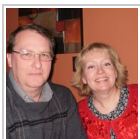
