Floyd R. Robison, 71, of Metamora, passed away at 8:15 a.m. Monday, February 23, 2015 at Washington Christian Village.

He was born June 17, 1943 in Bloomington, IL to Floyd O. and Dorothy J. Sherman Robison. He married Mary Ann Downey in Las Vegas, NV on September 23, 1992. She survives.

Also surviving are two sons, Daniel (and Stephen) Robison of CA, Jeffrey Robison of Peoria; and grandson, Landon. He was preceded in death by his parents.
