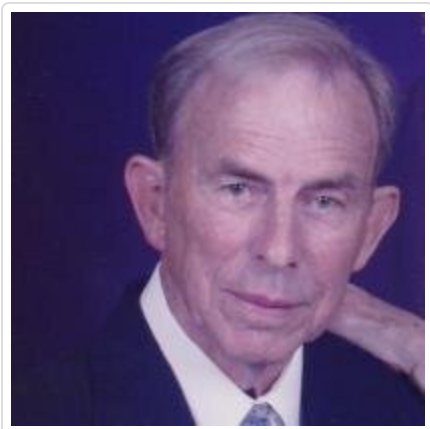




Guy M. Bordner

January 13, 1927 - March 27, 2015

Guy M. Bordner, 88, of Washington, formerly of East Peoria, passed away at 6:38am, Friday, March 27, 2015 at Washington Christian Village.

Guy was born January 13, 1927 in Lewistown. He was raised during the Depression by his mother, the late Telsa K. Taylor Bordner. He married Cora I. Beadles on September 1, 1950 in East Peoria. She preceded him in death in 2005.

Surviving are their children, Pam (George Riney) Bordner-Riney of Chicago, and Craig (Donna) Bordner of Mapleton; two grandsons, three step-grandsons, two step-granddaughters, and 12 great-grandchildren.

He was also preceded in death by an infant son, Glen, two sisters, and four brothers.

Guy served in the Pacific on the USS Schmitt during World War II. He went on to work for the T,P, & W Railroad in East Peoria, retiring as an engineer in 1982. He volunteered at Wildlife Prairie Park and was a member of the First United Methodist Church in East Peoria. His passion was gardening and he took great pride in it.

A funeral service for Guy will be held at 11:00am, Monday, March 30, 2015 at Deiters Funeral Home & Crematory in East Peoria. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service at the funeral home. Interment will be at Roberts Cemetery in Morton. Pastor Mary Arnold will officiate.

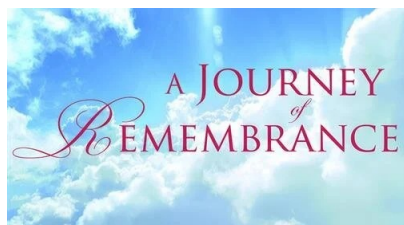
