James A. Spoon, 93, of Metamora, formerly of Washington, passed away at 9:35 am Monday, May 22, 2017 at Snyder Village in Metamora.

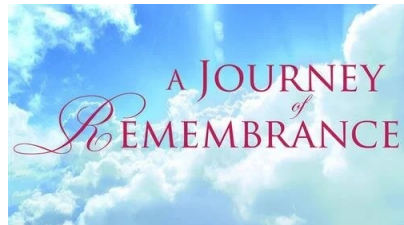
