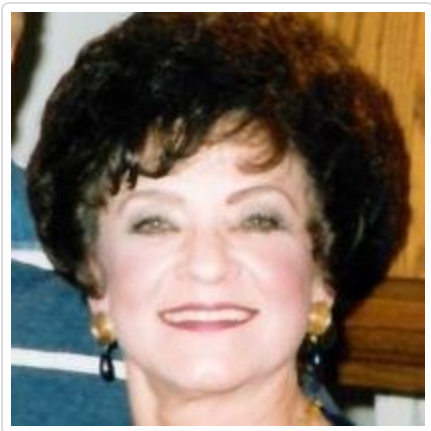




Janet McCully
