Stephen C. Schimpf, 59, of Washington, passed away at 7:15am, Monday, August 31, 2015 at his home.

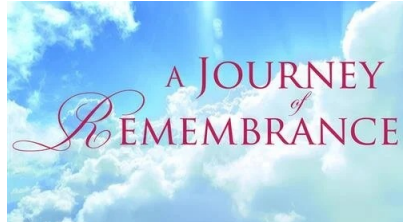
